

Express Tag Mounting Instructions



Positioning Your Express Tag

In a Car

The Tag should be attached to the inside of the front windscreen in about the centre of the vehicle. It should be at least 7cm down from the top of the windscreen and below any tinting or external sun visor. It should not be placed where it could obstruct your normal driving vision. Note many imported cars have metallic windscreens which will prevent any Tag from working, if you are unsure about your vehicle check with the cars owner manual for specific Tag mounting instructions.

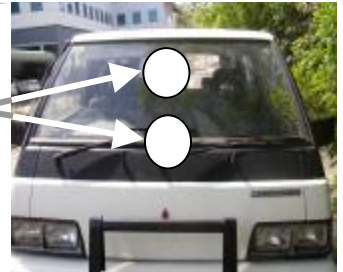


In a Truck, Van or Bus

The Tag should be placed in the middle top or bottom part of the windscreen noting the following points:

- The Tag should be located to ensure that there is at least a 7 cm clearance between the Tag and any metal object such as windscreen wipers, insect screen or sun visor.
- If the vehicle has a split windscreen the Tag should be placed to one side of the centre pillar.

On a Motorbike

The Tag should be mounted, or can be worn such that:

- The Express Tag adhesive pad is facing the direction of travel,
- It is protected from the weather as the Tag is **NOT WATERPROOF**. HINT: place Tag in a plastic zip lock bag for protection, don't leave it in the supplied Foil Bag as this will prevent it from working.
- When you pass through the tolling point the Tag should be in the centre of the lane.

Suitable locations to mount your tag include: on an armband (use a small mobile phone leather case to hold the Tag) on your upper arm or on your windscreen or fairing in a waterproof container. Note: Carrying the Tag in your backpack or saddlebags is not suitable. For assistance, call in to the Express Tag Service Centre.

Attaching Your Express Tag

Your Express Tag comes with its mounting bracket already attached. Do not attempt to remove the mounting bracket until you have attached the Express Tag to your windscreen. After identifying the correct mounting position follow these simple steps to mount the Tag.

- 1 Trial fit your Express Tag in the chosen location (without removing the adhesive backing) to check it will fit and the drivers vision is not obscured and there is at least 7cm clearance from any metal object.
- 2 Using the enclosed cleaning wipe (other cleaning products must not be used) clean the area on the windscreen where the Express Tag is going to be mounted. After cleaning, dry the windscreen using a clean dry tissue. TIP: The windscreen should be a minimum of 15°C and installation area must be dry. Avoid leaving fingerprints or blowing on the windscreen as this can weaken the adhesive bond.
- 3 Peel the backing paper from the tape on the backside of the Express Tag. TIP: Avoid contact with the sticky surface as this will weaken the adhesive bond.
- 4 Mount the Express Tag by holding it horizontal with the Express Tag Logo on the left hand side and push it onto the cleaned windscreen surface. Be careful to locate the Tag in the correct position as it will stick instantly and can't be moved once stuck. Push firmly against the Tag for 10 seconds.

To Remove the Express Tag from its mounting bracket.

Leave the Tag on the windscreen for at least 24 hours to allow the glue to harden before attempting to remove the Tag.

- 1 Hold the Tag with your thumb of your left hand under the thin end of the Tag and pull outwards.
- 2 To replace the Tag into the bracket, locate the hole on the back of the Tag over the top of the bracket. Hold the Tag with the thin end pointing slightly downwards. Push the Tag firmly against the bracket and twist in an anti-clockwise direction. The Tag will then click into place.

The Express Tag must be installed in accordance with these instructions otherwise it **WILL NOT WORK** and you may receive a Toll Infringement Notice.
